Dear Members and Neighbours,

As a matter of courtesy the Hythe Green Preservation would like to advise you of the following:

1 The Refurbishment of the Childrens Playgrounds

This work will begin on or after 8 September 2014. The designs were chosen by children from Hythe Bay School and all work will be within the existing boundaries.

2 Boundary Wall

We have been consulted by Hythe Town Council concerning their plans to remove the shrubbery and ivy between the wall and the path on the north side of the Green. All the shrubbery, including the buddleias planted by HGPS, is now completely overgrown and out of control, causing concern not only to the residents of Hermitage Close but also to those who use the footpath on the Green. The condition of the boundary wall appears in many places to have become unstable and therefore a potential health and safety risk.

The Hythe Green Preservation Society is positive that the shrubbery is currently free of all wildlife. However, it will be requested that consideration be given to the springtime nesting season and that the work take place during this period.

Hythe Town Council is currently investigating quotes to clear the shrubbery and for the area to be grassed. If you have any views on this, would you please contact: The Town Clerk, Hythe Town Council, Oaklands. Tel: 01303 266152.

3. REPLACEMENT OF BIN AT CINQUE PORTS AVENUE EXIT
